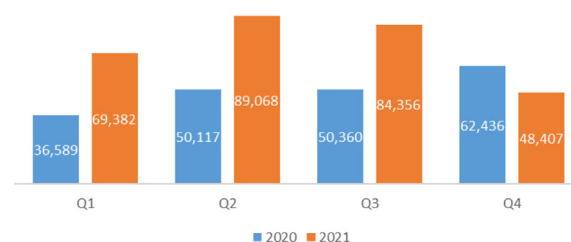

1. One thousand and one chimp nights: our 11th anniversary

With the publication of Volume 11, Issue 6 at the end of 2021, JCHIMP achieved the milestone of having passed 1000 published manuscripts in the 11 years of our existence, finishing with exactly 1001. This included a record 195 manuscripts in 2021 (up from 134 in volume 10, an increase of 45%), spurred by the unfortunate reality of the ongoing COVID tailwind. This mirrored the global trend, in which 191,359 manuscripts were published on COVID alone as of November 12, 2021.¹ As we wrote about in last years annual review, the sheer volume of publications has overwhelmed the peer review system.^{2,3} We are grateful to our peer reviewers for maintaining their rigorous standards and are happy to report that we have never had to retract an article.

2022 brings several changes for JCHIMP. Most obvious, perhaps, is the change in publisher. There will no doubt be growing pains as we move into Digital Commons, but the universality of their platform, and their mission-based publishing house, BePress, aligns well with our mission, vision, and values. We also hope that the publication platform will provide a more streamlined experience for our readers and peer reviewers as we seek to reduce logistical delays and subsequently the number of days from submission to the first decision; while it is presently an exceptional 47 days, on average, we believe that we can achieve 40 days or less without compromising the quality of peer review. We also hope to bring our readership and authors more precision in our citation metrics and impact factor.

Other major changes besides a new publisher includes Gillian Junker joining Jen Huff to work with the editors, authors, reviewers, and publisher. She has been essential to smooth out the details of changing publishers. Also new in this issue is a new topic titled “Cases from the Community” a CPC like series from community program highlighting interesting multidisciplinary management cases. We plan to alternate this with a Performance Improvement case-based presentations. We invite community programs to submit papers in these 2 areas, highlighting best practices from community hospitals.

In 2013 JCHIMP made the transition from its original publisher, Co-Action, to Taylor and Francis. For eight years Taylor and Francis served as our publisher, but now we must say good-bye. Starting on January 1st, 2022 the Journal of Community Hospital Internal Medicine Perspectives will no

longer be published by Taylor and Francis, but by the Greater Baltimore Medical Center with the assistance of Digital Commons. We are very excited to start self-publishing and cannot wait to see what the future holds for JCHIMP. On behalf of the JCHIMP Editorial Team we would like to thank Taylor and Francis for helping us with everything from pre-production to publication.

We are proud of our long and growing list of our peer reviewers, [Table 1](#), many of whom are peer reviewing for the first time including medical residents and medical students.
